The **Leadership Circle Hubs** connect researchers, professionals and organizations to facilitate communication, coordination, collaboration and innovation. The Hubs are fluid, dynamic and interconnected. Each Hub provides a strategic focal point for Leadership Circle members involved with or interested in different facets of life. By bringing together diverse leaders, we can share and apply knowledge while leveraging our respective strengths to build awareness, capacity, competency and community across the country.

Health Care Hub

The Health Care Hub is comprised of members from the health care sector, such as regulatory colleges, professional associations and recognized leaders focused on building awareness among family physicians, nurses, care providers, hospitals, health care institutions and more.

Mental Health Hub

The Mental Health Hub brings together leading organizations from the mental health care sector, including research and community organizations, mental health professionals and service providers, to build awareness among those who provide mental health services to families across Canada.

Education, Children and Youth Services Hub

The Education Hub provides educators, counsellors, curriculum designers and service providers with a forum for collaboration to ensure educational continuity and military literacy in schools.

Employment and Labour Hub
