Modern Family Finances: Income in Canada (statistical resource)

An up-to-date portrait of family income in Canada, which uses 2016 Census data to highlight the multifaceted nature of family income, diverse experiences with family finances and evolving trends over time that have an impact on families and family life.



Modern Family Finances: Seniors in Canada (statistical resource)

A bilingual and visually engaging resource that explores the economic well-being of seniors in Canada and their evolving relationship work and family, including statistics and data on labour trends, modern retirement, evolving income sources, low income households and more.



Students and Family Finances in Canada (infographic)

A colourful infographic highlighting the modern experiences and economic realities of postsecondary students in Canada, with data on topics such as university tuition costs, student debt and financial management strategies within families.



Fathers and Work in Canada (infographic)

An examination of fathers and work in Canada that compiles 2016 Census data to document men's growing role in family care and unpaid household work and looks at how parental leave and flexible work arrangements are accessed to facilitate fathers' family responsibilities.

A statistical glance at the diverse experiences of working mothers (and other working women) in Canada, with a focus on their rise in the paid labour market, employment patterns and the gender gap in paid and unpaid work.



A Snapshot of Men, Work and Family Relationships in Canada (statistical resource)

A statistical exploration of the diverse experiences of working fathers (and other working men) in Canada, with an emphasis on the growing contributions many are making to family life *outside* the workplace, such as with child care responsibilities and unpaid household work.
